

Guidelines:

- 1.** Together with your relatives, choose a day and time when everyone is usually at home and available, to join the Gospel at Home. Invite, and do not impose attendance
- 2.** Do not turn the meeting in psychic or mediunic session. Mediumship and spiritual assistance must be met in Spiritist Society
- 3.** You may place a pitcher or glass of water for blessing. The water should be drinkable and will be magnetized with good vibes during the meeting
- 4.** Avoid negative comments on religions or people, and keep the conversation positive and loving
- 5.** The weekly practice of the Gospel should not be interrupted, as we would not suspended our basic meals. If visitors, phone calls or surprises do arise, always prioritize the Gospel at Home
- 6.** The meeting should be about 15 minutes long. The time may be reduced if the person is alone
- 7.** Children: allow and encourage them to attend the meeting so they can develop their sense of religion and faith in God. "Let the little children come unto me and forbid them not ..." Jesus (Mark , 10:14).

Simplified Script for the Gospel at Home

"Dedicate one of the seven nights of the week to the Gospel Worship in the Home, so that Jesus can sleep in your home. When the home becomes a sanctuary, crime is left to the museum. When the family prays, Jesus stays at home. When hearts are united in the bonds of faith, balance supply blessings of comfort and health pours wine peace for all. Jesus is life in the home for the home."

Goals of Studying the Gospel

- To study The Gospel According to Spiritism helps us better understand the teachings of our Master Jesus in "spirit and truth", thus facilitating the experience of His example in our lives;
- To bring peace and understanding to your home, bringing together the beings who live under the same roof and giving them a more peaceful experience;
- To spiritually cleanse your home;
- To spread the moral concepts of the Gospel and to share it safely with family and friends;
- To receive the support necessary to overcome all material and spiritual challenges, following the principles taught by Jesus about prayer and vigilance;
- To improve the spiritual quality of family members so that you can more efficiently help the Good Spirits in obtaining a better world.

Steps:

Select a day and time of the week and invite all your family members to join the Gospel at Home. If they cannot or do not wish to participate, you may choose to do it on your own.

Remember, Jesus is always present through his messengers. The meeting should be about 15 minutes long and the chapters should be read out loud.

1. Opening: Say a simple and spontaneous prayer. You may do the Lord's Prayer.

2. Reading: Start from the beginning of The Gospel According to Spiritism and go until Chapter 28, the Lord's Prayer (Our Father). Read an item per week, or a small excerpt but always in sequence. If there are children or teenagers, see "Bibliography".

3. Commenting: Commenting should be brief and focused on the topic read, with the participation of all family members. Avoid criticism, discussions and overall controversial issues. Use the teachings for yourself as well.

4. Closing: Send thoughts of love, peace and health to people around the globe. Prayer suggestions:

- fraternity, peace and balance of all mankind;
- the expansion and experience of Jesus' message in every home;
- that your home, including all family members, be in vibration of love, harmony, health and lots of light. Master Jesus, bless this family and give us the understanding and the spirit of understanding and cooperation to increase the love and peace in our hearts.

5. Personal request (you may do this silently): You are talking to Jesus with your thoughts and heart. All of us have something to ask for, whether it be for more strength, courage, support to overcome difficulties or something else.

6. Closing Prayer: Say a simple and spontaneous prayer.
